

Logistics Crew

Objective:

To create the Outside Site venue grounds so it is visually appealing, effective and safe for patrons, volunteers and performers.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Set up and deconstruct the Outside Site logistical settings
- Move tables, chairs, equipment and canvas tents
- Construct the stage and other site areas as required

Qualifications & Requirements:

- Requires a great deal of lifting and carrying – must be comfortable with moving large and heavy objects
- Ability to commit to a full day of work before the festival
- Available the morning after the festival to deconstruct the site
- Prepared to take direction and follow instructions
- Enjoys working with others and is a great team player
- Access to a cordless screwdriver
- Comfortable and sturdy footwear needed - CSA approved recommended

Lines of Communication:

The Logistics Crew will be provided direction from, and supervised by, the Site Coordinator. Any questions or comments about the position should be directed to him/her.

Orientation:

There will be an orientation meeting for all Logistics Crew members prior to the festival. This will inform you of your specific duties and arrange the commitment of time.
